MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

And we kept our pace with our Community Blue Meals Program, thanks to Director Jacquie Banks.

Chief Koen met with the board on February 2 and shared some of the changes and challenges for the next year.

- Our front desk volunteer work was most appreciated and conducted with a high
 degree of professionalism. However, the City of Lakeway has decided to fund
 this as a full-time position, not unlike most other city administrative functions. This
 was started in May of 2019 and I can't begin to thank Priscilla Lagenour enough
 for her tireless efforts to create, coordinate and seamlessly run this program.
- Following a review by the city of its Employee Ethics Ordinance, we have been asked to put on hold our appreciation activities such our Community Blue Meals program. We are working with the city to resolve concerns while they are reviewing and revising this Ordinance.
- Chief Koen has communicated that he would like to resume the Citizen's Police Academy and we look forward to starting this again after a three-year hiatus.

We will continue to have volunteer opportunities with events such as the 4th of July Parade, NNO and PSD and will work with Chief Koen to identify other areas where LCPAAA may be of service.
